The sixth and seventh section is called Supervisor/Staff Reports and Management Reports. This section allows the District Administrator, Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. The eighth section is called Supervisor **Requests**. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the District's needs. The final section is called Audience Questions, Comments and Discussion Forum. This portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted.
